It touched my heart last Sunday morning to see how many people responded to the call for prayer for caregivers. I know there are others among us that didn't come forward that are providing significant help to another or even several others. In fact, very few of us will get through life without care giving being a significant part of our experience. Some wouldn't have it any other way while others feel trapped, isolated, overwhelmed, cheated... Most experience a mixture of the feelings of joy and loss as they do for others what they cannot do for themselves. Focusing our attention on the needs of a patient usually requires that less attention is given to others who are important to us or even to our own well being. I know of several that have neglected their own health, put concerns on the back burner, and spent the strength they had trying to meet the insatiable need of their loved one. Although little is understood about why one person develops dementia when others don't, one pattern they've discovered is that caregivers are more prone to the illness themselves. It is supposed that the increase of stress from care giving accounts for this phenomenon. Hurtful it is when relatives or friends question your service to your loved one suggesting that you could or should do even more. For some of you whose loved one has struggled with dementia or Alzheimer's or other degenerative conditions the patient may be the one questioning your love or care or may even be responding to your love with violence. You may feel alone but you are not. Start talking to others about your experiences and you will find that others live a similar life and would love to listen to your story even as they share theirs with you.
