"PROCLAIMING" (ACTS 5)

THE VIEW FROM MY WINDOW

Three captured sailors were placed one at a time in front of a firing squad on the beach. The first man was placed against a wall as the soldiers prepared to shoot. As the sergeant barked, "Ready...Aim..." the prisoner velled, "Tornado!" The hapless riflemen looked skyward as the man jumped over the wall & escaped. Noting what his friend had done the second man waited until the sergeant gave his commands: "Ready...Aim..." & the prisoner yelled, "Tsunami!" The squad turned to look at the ocean & the prisoner escaped.

The third man stood there wracking his brain for some disaster that might distract the gunmen. The sun was hot, the seconds ticked by. Think, think, think, he said to himself.
