THE VIEW FROM MY WINDOW

However, when this particular one saw us he looked startled, pointed his hind end at us & raised his tail! My heart skipped a beat & my feet shifted into a higher gear.

Again, he was out of range but that didn't prevent me from being alarmed. Have you ever been afraid of something of which you knew you shouldn't be afraid?

Have you ever shrunk from saying something you should have said? Paul tells us in today's text (Ephesians 6) that there are two things that will help: (1) prayer & (2) preparing to face whatever it was that previously caused you to respond poorly.
